



Incident Occurs Outside Combined Law Enforcement Facility *Individual Attempts Suicide In Parking Lot*

STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO-May 30, 2020-At approximately 3:35pm yesterday, May 29, a male in his 70s pulled up outside the Combined Law Enforcement Facility, 2027 Shield Drive, where he attempted to commit suicide outside the facility.

“On behalf of the department, our thoughts are with this individual’s family during this difficult time,” said Chief Cory Christensen with the Steamboat Springs Police Department. “This appears to be an isolated incident and no other individuals were harmed or threats received.”

When the man arrived in the parking lot of the facility, he pulled out a firearm and shot himself. Steamboat Springs Fire Rescue transported the individual to the Yampa Valley Medical Center, where he was later pronounced dead.

Steamboat Springs Police Detectives are investigating the incident. No additional information is available.
