



# Steamboat Springs Municipal Court

## You may not enter the building if:

- 1) You have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and you have not received a subsequent test confirming that you are currently virus-free;
- 2) You have been in direct contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past fourteen (14) days; or
- 3) You have symptoms of COVID-19 including fever, sore throat, cough, shortness of breath, persistent pain or pressure in your chest, body aches, fatigue, trouble breathing, new confusion or inability to arouse, bluish lips or face, recent loss of taste or smell, or any other symptoms of respiratory illness.

## Anyone who enters the facility must:

- All must wear a face mask and maintain 6-foot social distancing.
- Defendants will appear alone unless accompanied by an attorney or by a guardian as required for juveniles.
- Everyone must sign in and include their phone number, email address and mailing address upon entering the building.
- There is a maximum room capacity of nine (9) defendants and those who arrive after the room is full will sign in and then exit to wait outside the building until there is room available.
- The City of Steamboat Springs prosecutor will be on hand to either meet with defendants on court night or set an appointment to discuss your case by phone later.
- Payment for cases which have final orders are due on the night of court.

**Phone appointments with the prosecutor are available prior to your court date if you want to try to resolve your case without coming to court. Please contact the court at 970 871 8277. Please see the back of your ticket copy for further court information.**
