IMPORTANT ROAD CLOSURES

The City of Steamboat Springs would like to notify its citizens and visitors that Yampa Street, between 5th and 6th Streets will be closed Monday, September 22nd for paving (weather permitting).

One lane will remain open for two-way flagged traffic but you may want to use River Road as a good alternative for accessing the Howelsen area.

Connell Resources will be doing the paving and there will be extensive signage and multiple flaggers to redirect traffic.

CONSTRUCTION DETOURS ON LINCOLN AVENUE

Construction work will be continuing through November 15th on Lincoln Avenue between 4th Street and Old Fish Creek Falls Road as crews upgrade public water, sanitary sewer, and storm sewer infrastructure.

During this time there will be varying detours as they try to accomplish the work safely, quickly, and with the least amount of disruption feasible. Periodic updates will be provided on the City Page as work progresses.

The current phase of work involves installation of a new box culvert and a new sanitary sewer on the west side of Lincoln Avenue near the Blimpie's restaurant, and should last through October 10th.

All local businesses will remain open during construction. Two lanes of traffic in each direction will be maintained during daylight hours throughout the project. Congestion is anticipated, and alternate routes are advised.

SAFE WALKING TIPS

**Please keep the following tips in mind when you are out walking.
Cross at crosswalks or intersection.**

- Stay to the right in the crosswalk.
- Before crossing - look all ways.
- At signalized crosswalks, cross only on the proper signal.
- Watch for cars. Be sure the street is clear before you cross.
- Avoid crossing between parked cars.
- Where there is no sidewalk and it is necessary to walk in the roadway, walk on the left side, facing traffic.
- If you take your pet with you, use a leash.
- Wear or carry retro-reflective material at night to help drivers see you.
