# Important: US 40 Reconstruction update For Old Town Steamboat Springs 10/19-23, 2009

**Public Meeting:** Thursday, Oct. 22, 5:30 p.m. at City Hall (exact location TBA) Here's where you can get your questions answered by CDOT, city and Scott representatives.

## CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Work continues on the north side of Lincoln Ave. from 11<sup>h</sup> through 5th streets as we replace old metal storm drains with new concrete pipe moving west to east.

This project will be suspended during the heaviest snow months and resume as weather allows in spring. Our goal is to complete the project by June 20, 2010. Our typical work hours are from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM, Monday through Friday, with some night work to complete the 7<sup>th</sup> street work before our winter closure.

## TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

Two lanes are being kept open in the direction of the commute at 13<sup>th</sup> to aide with congestion. Travel delays of 10 minutes may be encountered in and around work zones during peak commute times and lunch-hour only. **Businesses will remain open** for the duration of the project, with alternate off-street parking on side streets and surrounding lots.

**Road Closures:** *This involves the north side of the following streets only, and means no turns onto or from Lincoln Av.), however, parking and business access is still available on these streets; south sides remain open to local traffic and to right-hand turns only onto Lincoln Av.*

- 11th will remain closed until Tuesday.
- 10th will remain closed until Wednesday
- 9th will be closed starting Monday until Thursday
- 8th will be closed starting Monday until Friday
- 6th will be closed starting Wednesday until 10-26-09
- 5th will be closed starting Wednesday until 10-26-09

*Closures occur only for the safety of motorists, cyclists and pedestrians. We greatly appreciate your patience during this project.*
