- **Public comment:**

- **Administrative Business**
  - Minutes February 9th – APPROVED 4-0. No Zach, Ian
- **Food and Beverage**
  - Contract is with Steamboat's legal
    - Contract is complete, hoping to approve once it gets back
  - Sleigh ride dinners at record numbers, 91 last Saturday
  - Fondu dinner last Wednesday
    - Most people came for dinner instead of the skiing/snowshoeing
  - On pace to exceed budget despite the loss of time in December and January
  - Discussion to begin on streamlining menu for tournaments and events
  - Meeting with designer on Monday to take a look and get an official quote on remodel
    - Will go into detail further on renovations once meeting at Haymaker so it will be easier to visualize
- **Superintendent**
  - Assistant superintendent position is officially posted, both internally with the externally within the city
  - Has some verbal commitments for staffing this season
  - Possibility Haymaker will need to go back to quarterly water testing
    - Maintain our water certification and keep our status
    - Likely to cost around \$12,000 per year
      - Option to create our own plan
  - Possibly able to get these things granted from sustainability funds within the city
    - Site visit happening this spring, and will reassess next steps
  - Snow thinning in areas
- **Golf Pro- Cody Hasten**
  - Staff Update:
    - Extended offer for direction of instruction and he accepted yesterday
      - Looking to be in Steamboat long term
      - Great experience
      - Looking to grow programs in the future

- Course will take 10% of cost
- Hired a Golf Shop Assistant
  - Excited about the couple events, will likely take over Apres events
- Working on hiring outside staff
  - Job listings are posted
  - Cody will be dropping off flyers around town, CMC, the High School
- Hockey Classic is planning on coming back
- Voyak will be joining us next season
- Tournament/league sign-ups:
  - Golf genius software is able to require people to pre-pay and set a cancellation policy
    - This will streamline the check-in process and give people a motive to show up
- **Chairman's Update- Katie O'Hara**
  - General update:
    - Still trying for the full-time, year-round position
      - Timely process that will take months to approve
      - Alternative would be to budget it for next budget season if we couldn't get it approved in time for this season
    - Tournament/league schedule is live online
