- **Public comment:**

- **Administrative Business**

 - **Food and Beverage**
 - Restaurant Contract Meeting rescheduled to February 9th @ 8:00
 - Winter operations:
 - a. Sleigh ride dinners have been successful with anywhere from 60-80 sleigh rides per night.
 - b. Planning on beginning restaurant prep for golf season
- **Superintendent**
 - Close to finalizing the driving range expansion
 - Received pump motor and pump motor installation is set for June
 - Still working at getting the job position finalized and possibly combining job descriptions
 - Sleigh ride dinners were held off until the right time to ensure preservation of the course
- **Golf Pro- Cody Hasten**
 - Cody is still trying to fill the director of Instruction position and has some good candidates
 - Next hiring steps for this position
 - a. Committee members can sit in on the interview process but official hiring will need to be done by the city.
 - Cody is taking a look at different simulators while in Florida and is dialing in logistics
 - a. Looking to get this done by the 1st of the year.
- Up to about 100 season pass sales
 - a. Cut off is February 1st for season pass sales
 - b. All season passes are currently/will continue to be paid in full

 - a. Katie mentioned it has been a positive experience for both them and the course in the past
