- **Public comment:**
  - N/A – Public was able to log in if desired.
- **Administrative Business**
  - May 12th Minutes – APPROVED (4-0)
  - Cancellation/refund request for Michael Feyen and his son.
    - APPROVED (4-0)
  - Discussing having an individual on board to help grow and run tournaments, leagues, and clinics.
- **Food & Beverage – Abbey Taylor**
  - Looking for a place for the menu on course (previously hole 8 was discussed but aesthetically may not be the best location)
    - Adam & Cody will go out to find a place and the rest of the committee will provide feedback at the next meeting.
  - There has been some negative feedback regarding the toilet paper rolls in the men's bathroom, which Abbey will pass along to the resort.
  - Facilities are scheduled to be repaired (broken light pole, entry gate, damaged curbs) via Ski Corps, with the exception parking lot painting which will be handled by the City street crew.
  - Locals week went well: the retro beers on the cart were a big success.
  - Three graduation parties happening this weekend, will be closing at 2:30 to set up for these.
    - Turn window and beverage cart will still be out and running.
  - Draught system should be installed first thing Monday morning.
- **Superintendent Update – Adam Sando**
  - Hired contractor to complete more work at starter shack site.
  - Lowered greens mowers and will continue dropping to target height the 5<sup>th</sup> of June.
  - Overseeding tee's that were damaged by winter.
  - Cleaning up the area and improving the aesthetic of the course for the summer with new plants and a set schedule for routine maintenance and cleaning.
    - 1<sup>st</sup> week of every month scheduled cleaning of the bunkers to keep up with maintenance.
    - Plan to drill and fill renovated tee's once a month.

- Smaller projects around the course will be undertaken to take advantage of a full staff.
- **Head Golf Professional – Cody Hasten**
  - Locals week has been a great success so far.
    - \$600 raised for Junior Golf Fund so far with more to be raised as the week goes on.
  - Haycup and Three Club tournaments have been filling up but still looking for more to sign up to fill the course entirely.
  - Junior golf starts in two weeks and registration has been filling up quickly.
  - Junior Golf Alliance of Colorado is next Tuesday: 70 total participants with 8 doing 9 holes and 62 doing 18.
  - Looking for an individual to work 2-3 shifts per week to fill an open flex position in the golf shop.
- **Marketing – Katie O'Hara**
  - Adam to do blurb for June e-blast.
  - Extra June e-blast from Cody regarding tournaments.
- **Finance-Sue Davies**
  - Budget sub-committee (Alan & Ian) have met twice to discuss CIP, with Ian meeting with Sue to discuss the entire process in depth.
  - Looking at historical data to brainstorm ways to increase revenue.
  - Potentially have an appraisal for building costs regarding insurance and a catastrophic event.
