- **Public comment:**
 - N/A – Public was able to log in if desired.
- **Administrative Business**
 - May 26th Minutes – APPROVED (5-0)
- **Food & Beverage – Abbey Taylor**
 - Plans to keep the bar open until 9 with the kitchen closing at 8 to accommodate later events.
 - Pre-order menus are ready for leagues (girls on the green, ladies and men's tournaments).
 - Draught system is good to go and should be ready for happy hour today.
 - Beverage carts are going well: Monday thru Thursday there is one on course and Friday thru Sunday there are two.
 - Beverage carts are contracted to begin operations at 10AM, but may begin earlier if things are happening earlier on the greens.
- **Superintendent Update – Adam Sando**
 - Finishing up verticut on front greens today.
 - Dropping mowers at the beginning of next week to target height.
 - It is shaping up to be a low water year, which brings the possibility that hand watering may be necessary.
 - Water will be an important topic to keep on the agenda moving forward.
 - 1,3, & 9 greens were thought to be an ice problem but turned out to be a bug problem and may take a full year to come back.
 - Starter shack is on the list of projects for June.
- **Head Golf Professional – Cody Hasten**
 - Leagues all started up this week-online sign ups are making things easy for users and employees, will work on education to mitigate user error issues.
 - 30 ladies showed up for ladies league with potential for growth.
 - Men's league is tomorrow with 21 signed up.
 - Three Club Tournament is this weekend with 50 players signed up.
 - Haycup Tournament, which is in two weeks, is officially full with 48 players.
 - Tournaments have positive and negative impacts on day sales/user experience, but in the end drive excitement and season pass sales and fill the course on days that may not be full.

- Strategize for next year's events to boost the impact.
- Junior leagues have had a huge turnout and clinics are filling up quickly.
- Searching for 1-2 golf shop employees.
- **Marketing – Katie O'Hara**
 - Potential feature in Avid Golfer to focus on tournaments.
 - In Adam's section in the newsletter there may be a section regarding the bugs on 1, 3, & 9.
- **Finance-Sue Davies**
 - Next step for the budget sub-committee is to meet with Cody & Adam before the next Haymaker Golf Committee meeting on June 23rd.
 - Discussing funding for CIP projects and where that funding will come from.
 - Prioritizing CIP projects.

 - A trial run has begun with Ally MacDougall in a tournament and event organization capacity.
