- **Public comment:**
  - John (20+ year pass holder representing senior golfers)
    - John is concerned he cannot get a tee time on Friday mornings
    - John would like to set up a senior golf group with tee times set aside
- **Administrative Business**
  - August 25th Minutes – APPROVED 5-0
  - Golf Committee went through the past survey questions and discuss removing and adding new questions.
- **Food & Beverage – Abbey Taylor**
  - Still very busy
    - Saturday Prime Rib had 100 reservations
  - Ready for large tournament tomorrow
  - Abbey is going to look at doing Tuesday Burger night for next year again
  - Next Apres Golf is September 23<sup>rd</sup>
  - Restaurant will start to close at 7pm on Monday 9/13
  - Starting to work on winter
- **Head Golf Professional – Cody Hasten**
  - Fall Classic coming up this weekend – 53 signed up
  - CMCA tournament tomorrow
  - City Championship signs up just started
    - Katie and Cody will coordinate marketing for this tournament
  - Cody shared numbers through August
  - Cody sent out an email to a group that is frustrated with the booking policies and not being able to get preferred tee times.
    - Cody and his staff are following the current policies in place for 60 days out for non-residents and 10 days out for residents.
    - Committee discussed ways to find a better balance next year and will continue to discuss policy options.
  - Ian asked what the protocol is for people to be notified if they were near someone with COVID.
    - Cody let the Committee know that when there was a tournament with someone who was diagnosed everyone who was within 6 feet for 15 minutes was notified.

- This is the protocol provided by Routt County Health Public Health department.
  
- **Superintendent Update**
  - Staffing is looking good going into fall
  - Tee box aerification will start Sept 20<sup>th</sup> and should not effect play.
  - Full aerification will start Oct 4<sup>th</sup> and will be closed for 4 days.
  - Deep tine aerification will be on October 7<sup>th</sup>.
  - Superintendents Revenge will be Tuesday, October 19th
