



Steamboat Springs Airport Draft Master Plan On Final Approach *Public Comment on Proposed Draft Plan Open Until February 22*

STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO-February 10, 2021-After numerous meetings, open houses and public input, the Steamboat Springs Airport Draft Master Plan is on final approach and is seeking public comment on the proposed plan before touchdown.

“The process has generated great input and suggestions over the more than year and counting process from a wide variety of entities,” said Project Manager Leah Whitfield with The Aviation Planning Group, the consultant on the project. “As a result, the final airport master plan will guide the orderly development of the Steamboat Springs Airport over the next 20 years.”

This master plan follows a systematic and sequential development, as required by the Federal Aviation Administration, which corresponds to the chapters of the report.

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) recommends that the Steamboat Springs Airport - Bob Adams Field Master Plan be updated every 10 years. The previous master plan for the Airport was written in 2008.
