



Touch A Truck Returns With Big Rigs, Big Fun & Sensory Hour

Local Organizations Showcase Vehicles During Hands-On August 7 Event

STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO-July 28, 2025-Get ready to rev your engines, Touch A Truck is rolling back into Steamboat Springs on Thursday, August 7, and it's bigger, louder (and quieter!) than ever. The event will again host a sensory quiet hour (no horns, sirens, etc.) beginning at 10am.

Touch A Truck brings together awesome rigs and the amazing people who drive them—from firefighters and police officers to bus drivers, construction workers, medics, and rescue crews. You'll see giant equipment, flashing lights, and even a helicopter (weather permitting), all ready to be explored. This is a mega showcase of specialized equipment used in each organization's line of work.

Kids (and adults) will be able to get up-close to climb, explore and discover their favorite big truck & equipment. Not only will you be able to climb inside many of the vehicles and take a ton of photos, but the operators will also be on hand to answer questions and explain how each piece of equipment works to keep our community in motion.

The big rigs scheduled to be on location include the signature red & white Classic Air Medical helicopter, a Steamboat Springs Fire Rescue fire truck, Steamboat Springs Police patrol cars & animal control van, Steamboat Springs Transit buses, and Routt County Sheriff's Office MARV (Mobile Armored Rescue Vehicle), Routt County Search & Rescue truck, Parks & Rec Blue Whale (bus), law enforcement agencies' combined SWAT unit vehicles and other equipment including a backhoe, mower and remote controlled water line inspection robot.



The Touch A Truck big rigs will be parked in the east end of the Rodeo Grounds parking lot closer to the Howelsen Ice Arena on Thursday, August 7, from 10am to noon with the sensory quiet hour running from 10am to 11am.

The event is free and open to all ages. Public parking will be available in the remaining rodeo ground parking areas. [Additional information can be found online.](#)
