



## Utility Undergrounding Project Closes 11<sup>th</sup> Street

Road Closure Starts August 13 and Runs Approximately 3 Days

**STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO-August 11, 2025**-As part of the utility undergrounding project in the alley between Oak Street and Lincoln Avenue (US 40), 11<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed for approximately three (3) days starting Wednesday, August 13, 2025. The closure is limited to traffic on 11<sup>th</sup> Street between Oak and Lincoln.

The closure is necessary for the installation of a duct bank — a system of protective PVC conduits encased in concrete that safely houses underground utility wires.

This work involves cutting through pavement, trenching, placing forms, and pouring concrete. Following the three-day installation period, an additional day is required to repave the road, which will likely occur in late August or early September.



Detours will be in place and motorists are encouraged to use 9<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> Streets as alternate routes during this time. All businesses remain open and accessible during the street closure.

Thank you for your patience as this essential infrastructure upgrade is completed.
