



## Special Meeting Reviews Amended SSRC Pledge Agreement

Council Meeting Set For 11am on Monday, August 25, in Citizens Hall

**STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO-August 22, 2025**-The Steamboat Springs City Council will hold a special meeting on Monday, August 25, 2025, at 11 a.m. to review the amended pledge agreement from Steamboat Ski & Resort Corporation (SSRC) committing \$1 million annually for three years to the Yampa Valley Regional Transportation Authority (RTA).

Because the next regular City Council meeting isn't until September 5, an immediate decision is needed ahead of Tuesday, August 26, when RTA partners begin final considerations.

Council will decide whether to move forward with the RTA intergovernmental agreement based on the new SSRC pledge.



The resort had pledged \$1 million annually over 20 years to the proposed Yampa Valley Regional Transportation Authority. The current pledge agreement from SSRC includes a three-year, \$3 million contribution to the RTA if voters approve the RTA this November. The agreement also includes a commitment to work with the RTA's board to finalize the terms of the remaining \$17 million pledge by April 1, 2027. The revised pledge agreement has been part of several negotiations and meetings with the RTA Formation Committee since early August.

All six jurisdictions—Routt County, Craig, Hayden, Yampa, Oak Creek, and Steamboat Springs—must approve the agreement and place the RTA ballot question by Friday, September 5, for it to go before voters this fall.
