

Alcohol Server Training Offered with Spanish Translation

Liquor Industry Questions & Understanding Our Regulations Session Set For Sept 18

STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO-September 10, 2025-The City of Steamboat Springs, in conjunction with Jeff Malchow, will host the next session of the LIQUOR training program — Liquor Industry Questions & Understanding Our Regulations — on Thursday, September 18, 2025, from 1pm to 3pm at the Citizens Meeting Room, 124 10th Street.

This state-approved course is specifically designed to help liquor-licensed establishments, and their employees better understand Colorado laws and local requirements around alcohol sales and service.

The training will also include live Spanish translation, making the program more accessible to all who serve alcohol in the community.

The training is geared toward owners, managers, bartenders, servers, retail employees, and special event volunteers.

Participants will gain a clear understanding of their responsibilities when serving alcohol, including how to check IDs, recognize signs of intoxication, handle difficult situations, and avoid liability. Attendees will also learn how alcohol service impacts both public safety and business compliance.

“Serving alcohol comes with serious responsibilities,” said Deputy City Clerk Heather Oss. “This training helps ensure everyone — from bartenders and wait staff to store clerks and event volunteers — knows how to do their job safely, legally, and responsibly. With the addition of Spanish translation this year, more employees will be able to participate and strengthen safe practices across our community.”

The cost of the course is \$35 per person, payable by cash, check, credit card, or Venmo on the day of training (make checks payable to Jeff Malchow). All participants will receive a Responsible Alcohol Vendor Certification upon completion.
