



Tee Up Your Chance to Serve: Apply for Golf Committee

Five-Person Committee Helps Oversee Haymaker Golf Course Direction

Steamboat Springs, Colorado-September 15, 2025- The City of Steamboat Springs is now accepting applications for three open seats on the Golf Management Committee, the citizen group that helps guide the management and operations of the city-owned Haymaker Golf Course.

The Golf Management Committee meets twice monthly—on the second and fourth Wednesday—at the Parks & Recreation office during winter months and at the golf course in summer.

The five-member committee works closely with city staff including the Head Golf Professional, Course Superintendent, Finance team, and the Parks & Recreation Director.

Each of the three seats carries a three-year term, ending October 31, 2028. Along with helping shape the direction of one of Colorado's premier public golf courses, committee members receive a Haymaker Golf Pass and a Howelsen Hill Ski Pass.

Located on 233 acres in the Yampa Valley, Haymaker Golf Course is a championship facility designed with a 'core layout' that features expansive greens, gentle undulations, and at least four sets of tees per hole, ranging from 5,059 to 7,308 yards. Known for its uninterrupted valley views and welcoming design, Haymaker offers a memorable playing experience for golfers of all skill levels.
