

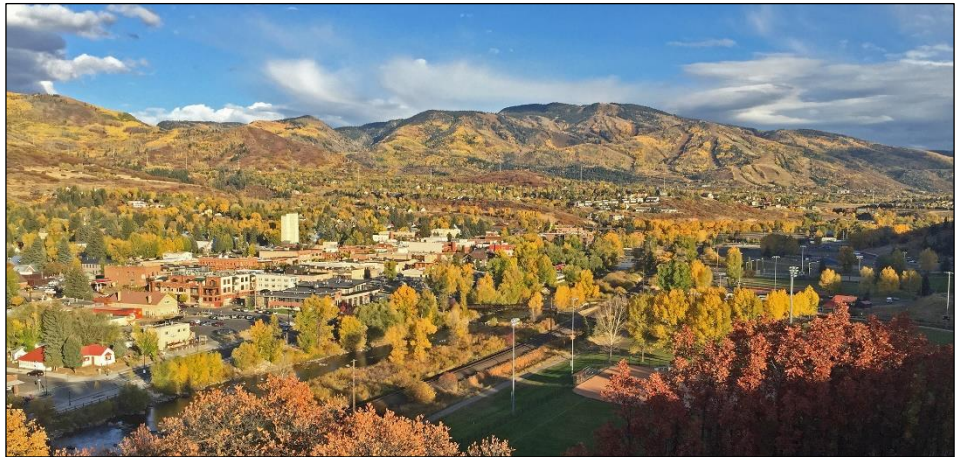


## Countdown to 2026 Community Support Funding Deadline

Applications For Arts & Culture, Environmental & Human Resource Coalitions

**STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO-October 9, 2025**-The City of Steamboat Springs reminds local organizations that the deadline to apply for 2026 Community Support Funding is October 15, 2025.

Over the past decade, the city has awarded nearly \$6 million to qualifying organizations across the Yampa Valley that enhance the community through arts, culture, environmental stewardship, and human services.



Each year, the city allocates several hundred thousand dollars to support organizations that fall within one of three funding coalitions:

- Arts & Culture
- Environmental
- Human Resource

Applications are reviewed by selection committees with expertise in each coalition's focus area. [All applications must be submitted online](#) by the October 15 deadline.

To be considered, requests must align with the following criteria:

- The activity or program reduces city service needs, fulfills a city goal, or aligns with City Council's Mission, Vision, and Values.
- The requested grant does not exceed 30% of the organization's total budget.
- The organization demonstrates strength and diversity in its funding sources.

In 2025, the city awarded \$851,902 to 42 local agencies and organizations, with individual awards ranging from \$2,000 to \$61,000.
