

2025/26 Howelsen Hill Season Passes On Sale

Most Affordable Way to Enjoy Winter at North America’s Longest Operating Ski Area

STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO-October 13, 2025-Mother Nature provide a great reminder that winter is just around the corner with the snow this past weekend. And this is your reminder that the most affordable way to enjoy a season of snow is currently on sale – a season pass to historic Howelsen Hill Ski Area.

[Season passes are available for purchase online and](#) at the Howelsen Hill ticket office during select pre-season hours. The historic ski area offers six pricing categories for passes providing Alpine, Nordic, or Alpine & Nordic access. Our youngest snow lovers (4 and under) continue to be FREE with special options for college, seniors, and families in addition to traditional adult/youth choices.

Again, this winter, a Howelsen Hill season pass provides even more affordability and flexibility with three days access to several resorts including Bogus Basin, Snow King Mountain, Steeplechase, Mont Du Lac and Hogadon Basin.

Passholders can have their pass preprinted in advance by [emailing the ticket office](#) a photo. If the photo is approved, the ticket office requires 48 hours to process the season pass.

Pre-season pass pickup hours will be posted online in the coming weeks. In addition, after purchasing your season pass online, individuals will need to visit the Howelsen Hill Ticket Office to take pass photo (if not provided in advance) and verify Liability Form.
