The hiring process includes a formal application, interview, written and physical ability tests, psychological evaluation, background check, and firefighter fitness and health screenings.

“No two days are ever alike,” added Deputy Chief Ian Satterfield. “Every call brings a new challenge that tests our skills and strengthens our commitment to serving the Yampa Valley.”

Steamboat Springs Fire Rescue is a department of the City of Steamboat Springs, operating under an intergovernmental agreement with the Steamboat Springs Area Fire Protection District. The department provides 24/7 emergency coverage across approximately 385 square miles, including the 10 square miles that make up the city itself.
