



## **Brown Ranch Community Solutions Explore Collaborative Effort To Define Decision Making Steps Between Agencies**

Project Funded Primarily From The Denver Foundation's Belonging Colorado Grant

**Steamboat Springs, Colorado-February 23, 2026-** A contracted facilitation team (Community Builders and Civic Canopy) will convene representatives from the City of Steamboat Springs, Routt County and the Yampa Valley Housing Authority (YVHA) for two meetings, the first on February 24 and the second on February 25, to discuss how the three agencies can develop a path forward on how to work together, in the best interest of the community, around a shared vision for the future of Brown Ranch.
